Preparation of a site plan to accommodate the education and recreation needs of Vancouver Island University (formerly Malaspina University -College), the District of North Cowichan and School District No. 79 (Cowichan Valley) on a single centrally located site adjacent to the Island Highway in the Cowichan Valley. The concept included sharing outdoor recreation fields and parking facilities to maximize the site's development potential. The new municipal swimming pool was completed in 2008 and a design build team for the first phase on the new Cowichan campus for Vancouver Island University was selected in June 2009. The final phase will consist of a new secondary school to replace the 50 year old Cowichan Secondary School.
