A study exploring the feasibility of a new museum for the City of Richmond was completed by the Arlington Group in 2009. The feasibility study examined the Richmond context in terms of ability to accommodate a new destination museum facility and a number of potential sites were studied in greater depth. In 2012 by request of the city this detailed feasibility study was updated, including a review of the context changes since the 2009 study such as the opening of the Canada Line and the significant population growth taking place by the City of Richmond.
