The Arlington Group was retained by Alberta Parks to undertake a demand analysis for potential environmental education and interpretation, outdoor recreation, and tourism uses of the Winagami Conservation Area. Extensive ranges of stakeholders were contacted to assist in the development of recommendations for its future use. Three development options with varying features and costs were prepared for the Winagami Conservation Area in keeping with the overall objectives. The draft report and three development options were presented to a meeting of stakeholders in the town of McLennan in January 2011.
